The new draft **Local Plan** which sets out how the district will grow sustainably over the next 15—20 years is open for consultation. The plan features proposals for housing and employment and a range of policies which will help guide development and link them to improvements in infrastructure. It also sets out new information on open spaces, green infrastructure and places of ecological value. The consultation, which includes proposals for future house building sites on Heights Lane, Lady Lane and Sty Lane, is open until Wednesday 24 Mar.
