Lord our God,

we are gathered here on this day
to consider how you have carried out your good,
firm will for the world and for all of us,
by allowing our Lord Jesus Christ, your dear Son,
to be captured that we might be free;
to be found guilty that we might be found innocent;
to suffer that we might rejoice;
and to be given over to death that we might live forever.
Under our own power, we could only be lost.
And we have not deserved such a rescue—no, not one of us.
But in the inconceivable greatness of your mercy,
you have shared in our sin and our poverty,
in order to do such a great thing for us.
How else could we thank you but to grasp, take up,
and acknowledge this great thing?
How else should this happen,
but that the same living Saviour
who suffered for us, was crucified, died, and buried,
and was also raised up, should now come into our midst,
speak to our hearts and minds, open us to your love,
and guide us to trust in it completely
and to live by it and by it alone.
So we ask in all humility, but also in all confidence,
that this happen in the power of your Holy Spirit. Amen.

Encouraging!

The theme of the fourth session in our Rhythm of life Lent course was 'Encouraging'. We were invited to think about the people who have encouraged us in our faith journey in the past, and those who encourage us now, and what we ourselves can do, to encourage others. It is important that we all think seriously about how we can be encouragers as we face the prospect of the weeks and months ahead, as the doors of our church buildings are opened up again. When will it be right to venture out, and to venture in? Of course, we are dependent upon the successful rolling out of the government's timetable, but we can perhaps start thinking of three stages in a process of encouragement: **(1)** each of us asking ourselves "When will it be right for me to go to church?" **(2)** conversations with members of our Good Shepherd Groups around the same kind of question: "When are you planning to go to church?" **(3)** conversations with people we know in other contexts: "Our church services have started up again—do you fancy coming along?" How many conversations like this could we commit to having each week? 1, 2, 10? How many could you commit to?
