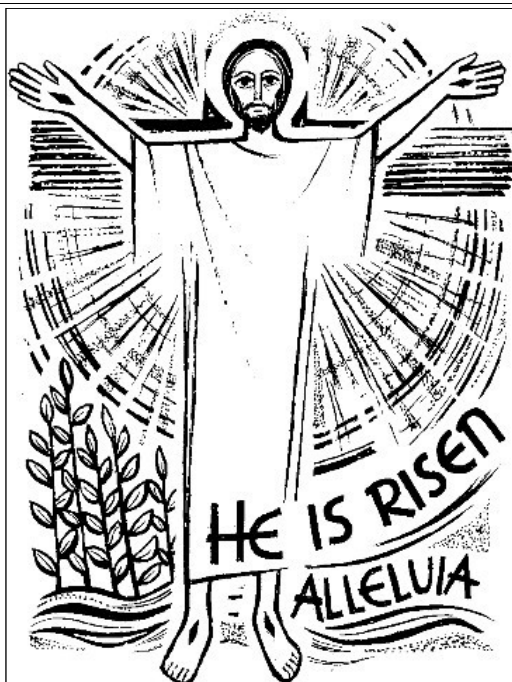

Today's Readings:

Acts 4.32-35: Their experience of the risen Christ led the first believers to share everything, laying all their possessions "at the apostles feet". Barnabas was especially generous.

1 John 1.1—2.2: John affirms his conviction that God's gifts of eternal life and light are only to be found in Christ. He alone can bring us the forgiveness of our sins.

John 20.19—31: The risen Christ appears to the disciples when Thomas is not with them. Thomas refuses to believe them when they tell him they have seen the Lord. Only when Jesus appears again and tells him to touch the wounds on his body does Thomas make his declaration of faith.

Laptops for Schools

Do you have an old laptop (under 7 years) that you could donate to help local students? Though schools have returned, there is still a need for laptops to help with catch-up work and home learning. Bingley Community Partnership, a group of local volunteering organisations of which our parish is part and local IT company Nevis have agreed to a scheme to clean up and restore used machines which can then be passed onto Bingley schools. Laptops need to have all charging and power cables and must be bagged or boxed so they can be quarantined before work takes place. No Apple tech please; these are too difficult to restore. Encouraging!

The theme of the fourth session in our Rhythm of life Lent course was 'Encouraging'. We were invited to think about the people who have encouraged us in our faith journey in the past, and those who encourage us now, and what we ourselves can do, to encourage others. It is important that we all think seriously about how we can be encouragers as we face the prospect of the weeks and months ahead, as the doors of our church buildings are opened up again. When will it be right to venture out, and to venture in? Of course, we are dependent upon the successful rolling out of the government's timetable, but we can perhaps start thinking of three stages in a process of encouragement: (1) each of us asking ourselves "When will it be right for me to go to church?" (2) conversations with members of our Good Shepherd Groups around the same kind of question: "When are you planning to go to church?" (3) conversations with people we know in other contexts: "Our church services have started up again—do you fancy coming along?" How many conversations like this could we commit to having each week? 1, 2, 10? How many could you commit to?
