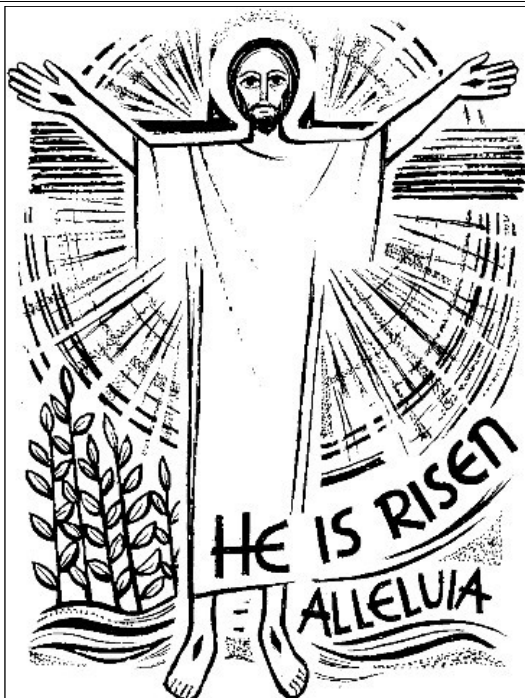

### Today's Readings:

**Acts 3.12-19:** Peter explains to astonished witnesses how the miracles they see are connected with the recent events of Jesus' death and resurrection; they illustrate what faith in the resurrected Christ can do.

**1 John 3.1-7:** John tells the wonderful news that every Christian has become a child of God, and as such, their actions must reflect the goodness of God. There is no place for continued and wilful wrongdoing in their lives.

**Luke 24.36b-48:** The resurrected Christ appears to the terrified and unbelieving disciples. He reassures them and they finally believe it is really him. He commissions them for the next step in the task to take the good news into the world.

### Christian Aid Week—10 to 16 May (from Tony Plumbe)

The focus for Christian Aid Week 2021 will be on the Climate Emergency. Locally, we will be mounting a 'distribution only' envelope collection and an electronic based appeal for donations. If you live in an area where we have a distributor, please expect a red envelope to come through your letter box. In line with COVID-19 guidance, this should be returned with your donation as directed on the envelope to either the collection letter box of a designated trusted distributor or to one of the special buckets located at 'collection centres', which will mostly be helpful shops. Envelopes without collection details may also be available at church services and can be returned via church collections. All envelopes have Gift Aid slips attached. **We need more distributors: if you could help with envelope distribution, please contact Tony on 01274 566607. This can be done as part of your local walk** Electronic donations can be made by direct bank transfer to our bank account which has the name 'Bingley Christian Aid Committee', the sorting code 20-76-92 and account number 83772594. Alternatively, donations can be made via the Christian Aid website <https://www.christianaid.org.uk/appeals/key-appeals/christian-aid-week>. The Christian Aid website allows 'gift aiding' automatically, if you tick the right box, but if you want to gift aid donations made via our bank account please contact Tony Plumbe (number above) and he will get the necessary slip to you. It is hoped that people living locally will be able to respond generously this Christian Aid Week, as we managed to raise only around 20% of our normal total in 2020. Cuts to the British Aid budget are impinging on Christian Aid direct and match funding. Christian Aid European funding has also been severed this year. The poorest and most vulnerable communities across the world have little hope of accessing any COVID-19 vaccine roll-out while rich nations monopolise supplies, but Christian Aid reaches those communities with practical support.

This local Befriending scheme matches someone who would like company with a trained volunteer who will meet or telephone them for support and general conversation or go for short walks to improve mobility. A weekly contact could be for: A cup of tea and a chat / A short stroll / A phone call.

### Encouraging!

The theme of the fourth session in our Rhythm of life Lent course was 'Encouraging'. We were invited to think about the people who have encouraged us in our faith journey in the past, and those who encourage us now, and what we ourselves can do, to encourage others. It is important that we all think seriously about how we can be encouragers as we face the prospect of the weeks and months ahead, as the doors of our church buildings are opened up again. When will it be right to venture out, and to venture in? Of course, we are dependent upon the successful rolling out of the government's timetable, but we can perhaps start thinking of three stages in a process of encouragement: (1) each of us asking ourselves "When will it be right for me to go to church?" (2) conversations with members of our Good Shepherd Groups around the same kind of question: "When are you planning to go to church?" (3) conversations with people we know in other contexts: "Our church services have started up again—do you fancy coming along?" How many conversations like this could we commit to having each week? 1, 2, 10? How many could you commit to?
